

Fall 2023 American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

For college students pursuing a degree and career related to the planning, design, or construction of highways.

It is ASHE's intent to award at least 3 scholarships to 3 separate eligible candidates.

Eligibility and Instructions

Eligibility:

- 1. Enrolled in a university located in the state of Arizona.
- 2. Enrolled in a Bachelor degree program related to transportation planning/engineering/construction.
- 3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in your junior or senior year for the Spring 2024 semester.
- 4. Must not be on academic probation.
- 5. Must not have already received an ASHE scholarship in a prior year.
- 6. Must be able to accept the award in person at the December 12, 2023 ASHE Section Meeting Breakfast in Phoenix, AZ.

Instructions:

- 2. Complete the application. The application must be typed and your responses cannot exceed the space provided.
- 3. Attach a copy of your current (Spring 2023) transcripts.

If Awarded:
